#### Fourth Announcement (March 31, 2004)

- (1) Participants, program and schedule. As of March 26, we have 54 registered participants, most of whom will also be speakers. The talks will cover a broad range of subjects; I'm sure the workshop will prove interesting to all of us. An **updated schedule** and agenda, dated March 30, is now or will soon be posted to the [ELOUD04 main website](#). In consideration of the travel plans of many of you, we will **end the workshop just before lunch on Friday April 23rd**, hence Friday lunch has been eliminated from the program.
- (2) Equipment. We will have a **Macintosh laptop**, plus (almost certainly) a **PC laptop**, hooked up to an **LCD projector** for PowerPoint or PDF presentations. We will also have an **overhead viewgraph projector**. The Napa Embassy Suites provides fast, free, **wireless internet** access in the conference room and in the bedrooms. We will have a small **USB inkjet printer** for last-minute minor printing jobs of transparencies or hardcopies. **Photocopying** facilities will be minimal at the hotel, although there is at least one commercial photocopying outfit in town.
- (3) Instructions for the presentations. In order to minimize the transition time between speakers, we intend to use, as much as possible, only our own laptop(s) for the presentations. Therefore, please email us your presentations by **Tuesday April 13**. If you use PowerPoint, please send us **both the original PPT plus a PDF** versions of your talk. When preparing the PDF version, **please use "font embedding"**. Kindly email your files directly to our admin assistant Tom Gallant at [TGGallant@lbl.gov](mailto:TGGallant@lbl.gov). If you do not bring your own laptop, we urge you to bring a **backup** of your electronic presentation either on a CD or USB memory stick (use viewgraphs as a last resort). We are aware that some of you will be preparing your presentation(s) up until the last minute and may need to use your own laptop; we encourage you, however, to send us your files in advance.
- (4) Paper submission. The deadline will be some time after the end of the workshop. Details will be announced at the workshop and instructions will be emailed to participants.
